Role Summary

Join our youth team as a Part-Time Youth Intern of a community where teens of all different backgrounds from ages 11-18 can discover life to the full in Christ, experience transformation, and partner with Him and each other in seeking justice and mercy for all people.

This is an opportunity for an individual to gain practical youth ministry experience among Jr. & Sr. youth age groups, receive discipleship and mentorship, and actively discern a call to ministry.

The intern will partner with the youth pastor to plan and conduct programs, communicate effectively with the community, and participate in visioning for the ministry. They will be delegated authority to lead among the wider Youth Leadership team. The candidate we seek will be energized by welcoming and walking alongside youth and feel called to invest in them.

Position Type: Permanent - Part-time (7.5 hours a week)

Working Relationships: Reports directly to Granville Chapel's Youth Pastor (Max Janssen), works collaboratively with volunteer leaders

Requirements:

- Exemplification of spiritual and emotional maturity and ongoing personal spiritual growth
- Relevant experience in youth ministry, leadership, mentoring, and discipling students
- Membership at Granville Chapel for at least 2 years
- Minimum 1-year service within Granville Chapel's youth ministry
- Ability to engage in meaningful conversations with teenagers

Responsibilities:

- Help to plan, lead and occasionally teach at Jr. & Sr. youth events
- Meet weekly/bi-weekly with the youth pastor for mentorship and coaching
- Attend other youth events and camps as decided
- Connect relationally with youth and parents outside of the Sunday service (To have fun, share life experiences, provide mentorship, celebrate big moments, grieve tough moments, and just hangout!)
- Devote themselves to prayer for the ministry, the youth, and the volunteer leaders
