YEAR-END GIVING

As we approach the end of our 2023 fiscal year, there are several giving options to help us meet the budget and receive a 2023 charitable tax receipt (donations must be dated and received or mailed no later than 11:59 pm on Dec. 31, 2023):

1. In-Person Giving

The last opportunity for in-person giving is during our Christmas Eve service (4:30pm – 6pm) on Dec 24th. Please place offerings in our mailbox beside the door along 43rd Avenue by 11:59 pm Dec 31, 2023.

2. Online

Donations can be made online at granvillechapel.com/give (scroll down to the Online Giving option and click the Donate Now button – online giving is processed and receipted through CanadaHelps).

3. Mail or Drop Off

Donations mailed to the church office must bear a postmark on the envelope dated no later than Dec 31, 2023 in order to be eligible for a 2023 tax receipt. For drop off, donations must be received in the church office or dropped in our silver mailbox beside the door along 43rd Avenue by 11:59 pm Dec 31, 2023.
